Acceptable Items for Patients

- 5 changes of comfortable clothing
 - Undergarments (no under-wire bras or thong underwear allowed)
 - Pajamas or sleep shirt
 - Socks & tennis shoes with no shoestrings
 - One stuffed animal or soft doll (no strings)
Must be less than 12 inches in size
 - Paperback books
 - Insurance & social security card
 - Medications
- Patients are encouraged to leave valuable property at home or with a guardian. Methodist Behavioral Hospital will not accept responsibility for jewelry or other valuables.
 - Only a limited number of items can be stored in a locked area due to limited space. Patients are encouraged to bring basic items only.
 - Personal hygiene and grooming products are provided by the hospital.
 - Items such as contact lenses and contact solution, special hygiene items, etc. are acceptable on an individual basis, pending approval by authorized staff.

2. Turn west on AR-365 N
3. Slight left onto AR-100 E (Maumelle Blvd)
4. Left on Rolling Oaks/Murphy Drive (immediately after railroad track overpass)
